European Certificate in Essential Palliative Care (ECEPC)

Developed at Princess Alice Hospice in 2001, over 15,000 European candidates have now completed this highly respected qualification.

The course is offered both nationally and internationally and North London Hospice are proud to work alongside Princess Alice as a local site.

ECEPC is a nine-week distance learning, multi-professional programme, suitable for doctors, nurses and associated healthcare professionals who have direct contact with patients requiring a palliative approach.

All candidates are provided with an extensive course handbook, access to a comprehensive virtual learning site and are assigned a facilitator to support them through the course.
