

North London Hospice's terms and conditions for Skydive Day 2026

By taking part in the Skydive day you agree to the terms and conditions below which is required by law under the fundraising regulator.

1. I confirm that I will be over the age of 16 on the day of the event. If I am under the age of 18, I understand I must have a guardian's written permission to jump.
2. I acknowledge that I am taking part in the skydive at my own risk and North London Hospice cannot accept liability for any loss or damage to personal property, fundraising income or injury. I understand that I must seek medical advice about any health concerns I may have about participating.
3. I understand that the registration fee is completely non-refundable and does not contribute towards my fundraising target.
4. I understand that a fee of £50 will be charged for all cancellations or changes to my skydive if made within two weeks of the original jump date. I understand this fee will increase to £100 for all cancellations or changes made within 7 workdays of the original jump date. I understand this is not in any way deductible from any sponsorship money raised for the charity.
5. I will use my best endeavours to raise money for North London Hospice in connection with my participation in the event and aim to raise a minimum of £395.
6. I will ask all sponsors (unless they are donating via my online sponsorship page) to complete a sponsorship form which will include an option for sponsors to ensure their donation also attracts gift aid and I understand that I must only use the sponsorship form(s) provided by North London Hospice. I understand that Gift Aid does not count towards my fundraising target.
7. I understand and will make clear to all sponsors that sponsorship money is given by way of donation. If I fail to take part in, or withdraw from, the event, any sponsorship collected will be refunded to the donor or gifted to North London Hospice.
8. Any fundraising I undertake in connection with my participation in the event will be for North London Hospice only. I understand that all fundraising must be paid directly to North London Hospice within one calendar month of the event.
9. I understand I must follow North London Hospices procedure for use of fundraising materials, and I will acquire the relevant licensing for collections or events I may hold. All fundraising material must be return to North London Hospice after use.
10. I will immediately inform North London Hospice if anything happens which puts my participation in doubt.
11. I have provided North London Hospice with the correct information. For more information on data, please refer to our [privacy policy](#).
12. I will not do anything to bring North London Hospice into disrepute. If I do so, North London Hospice has the right to withdraw my place.

13. I give permission for the free use of any pictures or video footage taken by North London Hospice on the day for promotional advertising or other uses as deemed appropriate.

Medical Restrictions

For a tandem skydive you must be at least 16 years old and must weigh under 15 stone 7 with your weight in proportion to your height. The principal medical restrictions are diabetes, epilepsy, fits, recurrent blackouts, heart or lung disease, mental illness and some cases of asthma but if you are in any doubt please contact Skyline for further information. You will be required to sign a medical form before your jump declaring your fitness to take part - this will be sent to you upon receipt of your reservation form but is also available on request. Those under the age of 18 will need the medical form signed by a parent or guardian; those aged 40 and over, or those with a medical condition, will need it signed by their doctor.

Insurance

On payment to the parachute centre of the fee for the training and the jump, all jumpers are covered by the British Parachute Association Liability Insurance Policy up to £2 million for liability to Third Parties. Please note that this does not cover you or your dependants for personal injury including death. You are therefore strongly recommended to take out your own insurance cover for personal accident benefits to whatever level you consider appropriate. If in any doubt you should seek independent advice.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Parachuting is an adventure sport and participation in such sports necessarily involves a risk of injury or death regardless of the standard of training, supervision and equipment employed. I voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in the sport and I agree for myself and my personal representatives to indemnify and hold harmless Skyline Promotions Ltd or North London Hospice against any claim or claims whether on my own account or from third parties arising out of any accident or incident resulting in any loss or damage (including bodily injury and death).

I confirm I have read all the above sections marked Terms and Conditions, Medical Restrictions, Insurance and Important Notice, and I understand and agree to be bound to those terms and conditions and to comply fully with the same.
